The Primary Industries AgTech PhD Scholarship will support a full time PhD student undertaking research to aid or improve primary industry production or profitability through the application of technology.

Expression of Interest (EOI)

To be considered for the Primary Industries AgTech PhD Scholarship at The University of Adelaide, applicants are required to:

- meet the eligibility criteria listed below
- make contact with a potential Principal Supervisor
- complete all sections of the EOI form
- provide all requested documents
- be available to attend an interview (upon invitation only) in December 2019.

How to apply?

- complete all sections of the EOI form
- attach a current Curriculum Vitaé
- attach copies of official Academic Transcripts for all academic qualifications you hold
- submit the EOI and documents by 20 November 2019 to: PIRSA.SARDIExecutiveOffice@sa.gov.au

Eligibility Criteria

In order to be eligible, an applicant **must**:

- have completed and been awarded an Australian First Class Honours Degree or equivalent;
- be a domestic student (domestic students are anyone who is Australian citizen, a New Zealand citizen or an Australian Permanent Resident);
- be eligible to enrol in a full-time Higher Degree by Research program at The University of Adelaide;
- not currently be in receipt of RTP Scholarships, or any other equivalent award or scholarship from an overseas sponsor or the Commonwealth Government designed to offset HDR fees;
- not be in receipt of an equivalent award, scholarship or salary to undertake the proposed degree (equivalent being defined as greater than 75% of the base stipend);
- not be currently enrolled in a higher degree by research at University of Adelaide;
- not currently be in receipt of a University of Adelaide Scholarship;
- not have held a University of Adelaide Scholarship to complete a Higher Degree by Research program or equivalent research qualification for longer than 6 months in the preceding 5 years (except Master of Philosophy (No Honours) Scholarship).
