Abstract

Notification of infectious diseases in South Australia is reported to the Communicable Disease Control Branch (SA Health) by medical officers and laboratories. This data is stored in CDCB's notifiable disease surveillance system and captures data ranging from demographics, clinical information, risk factors, potential sources of infection as well as additional enhanced surveillance data depending on the infectious disease. This research project has scope for a range of topics utilising the data capture and management disease surveillance systems available in CDCB and will include data analysis.
