



Health promotion in culturally and linguistically diverse populations: Muslim communities as an example

Abstract

The aim of this project is to develop best practice framework for co-designed, strength-based health promotion work in the CALD community with Muslim community as an example.

In the first phase of the work the student will extensively consult with community leaders (health professionals and faith leaders) and community members across metro and regional South Australia to develop a best practice framework for co-designed, strength-based and culturally sensitive health promotion work in the community. In the second phase of the work the student will work with the community members in Adelaide SA to focus on a prevention issue such as vaccination, for development, administration and evaluation of this using the co-designed framework. In the last phase of the work, the student will evaluate the effectiveness of the approach and formulate an adaptable framework for other CALD communities.
