



THE IAN WILSON LIBERAL RESEARCH SCHOLARSHIP (CATEGORY A)

Rules

Enabled to do so by a gift to the University of Adelaide by the Ian Wilson Liberal Research & Support Organisation Incorporated, the University has established a number of scholarships and made the following rules relating to them:

1. The Scholarships will be formally named The Ian Wilson Liberal Research Scholarship.
2. The purpose of the scholarship is to enable applicants to undertake further postgraduate research study. The scholarship is open to applicants undertaking research which will lead to sound analysis and conclusions for reform capable of practical application and advocacy in Australia, in the fields of:
 - a. social policy, including policy relating to:
 - i. social security and welfare payments and income support schemes;
 - ii. taxation; and
 - iii. superannuation and other forms of retirement income provision
 - b. education and health as they affect individual and family well being
 - c. jurisprudence, constitutional law and Commonwealth-State relations;
 - d. environment
 - e. heritage
 - f. the arts, and
 - g. indigenous affairs

Eligibility

3. The Scholarship is intended to supplement a major scholarship held by the recipient at the University of Adelaide, but not to affect the recipient's ability to accept other major scholarships, nor reduce a major award, subject to the terms and conditions of the major scholarship.

Tenure

4. Until otherwise determined by the Research Education and Development Committee, the number of scholarships available for award in each year shall be determined by the available income.

Benefits

5. The value of the supplementary scholarship shall be determined by the income derived from the interest of the Gift. It is anticipated that the award will be a minimum of \$5,000 per annum. The number of scholarships available each year, their value and tenure will be at the discretion of the Selection Committee. Payments will be made fortnightly subject to satisfactory progress as determined by the University. No other allowances will be payable

Applications and Selection

6. Applications must be lodged with the Adelaide Graduate Research School not later than the closing date indicated on the Application Form. The successful applicant will be selected by the University on the grounds of their academic merit, research potential and relevant area of research.

7. The successful applicant will be under no obligation whatsoever to render any service to the Ian Wilson Liberal Research & Support Organisation Incorporated, The Menzies Research Centre Limited or the University of Adelaide as a result of receiving this Scholarship.

Conditions of Award

8. In addition to the above rules, the recipient will be subject to the general Conditions of Research Award of the University of Adelaide. Where there is any conflict between the rules and conditions, the more restrictive condition will apply.

Please note:

Category B awards for Academic Staff are administered within the School of Social Sciences. Applications will be called for each year, by the School.
